GP involvement in panel activities

- Steering committee payments
- Increase hourly rate for GP involvement
- Activity payment – outcome based
- Reviewing protocols
- Completing surveys
- Paying a stipend amount for involvement in panels with expectation that equipment ‘tools of the trade’ can be purchased

GP Education – building capacity/competence of GP work force in Aged Care

- Attending Aged Care education
- Pilot use of quality MBS Items
 - putting systems in place to use these items
- Payment for GP mentors in Aged Care
- Payment for undertaking any CME activity; Active learning module, supervised clinical attachments, small group learning
- Academic detailing on use of MBS items
 - Peer training

Working Groups

- Payments for working groups such as; RMMR implementation, Medication Management, after hours

Involvement in Aged Care Facilities

- GP Education of care staff & carers
- Interviews with Directors of Nursing such as; needs assessment
- Payments for GPs to attend meetings of GPs & ACF to address/resolve an issue or implement a system change such as; introducing CMAs for all residents

Regional Committees

- Chairing regional Quality Care Committees
- Involvement in Medication Advisory committees
