

Possible Divisional Models

Model 1

Create a single Divisional list of GPs interested in promoting & participating in selected activities identified by RACFs and GPs, endorsed by Divisions Board.

Model 2

Create a network of postcode based focus groups comprising GPs & RACFs to work at improving services at the local level. These may elect some of their number to a central panel for wider input.

Model 3

Identify the most pressing issues in Aged Care (Medication, After Hours, Documentation etc) create sub panel focus groups and invite GPs & RACF to nominate for membership of these. Focus groups nominate to a central panel to disseminate and distribute recommendations.

Model 4

Invite individual RACFs to meet with their GPs (supported by Division) to develop an individual program for quality improvement.

Model 5

Invite individual GPs to provide Academic detailing on a Facility or small group basis across the Division.

Model 6

Invite individual GPs to prepare a Quality Improvement proposal for their own RACF to be negotiated with the facility
