Project extension

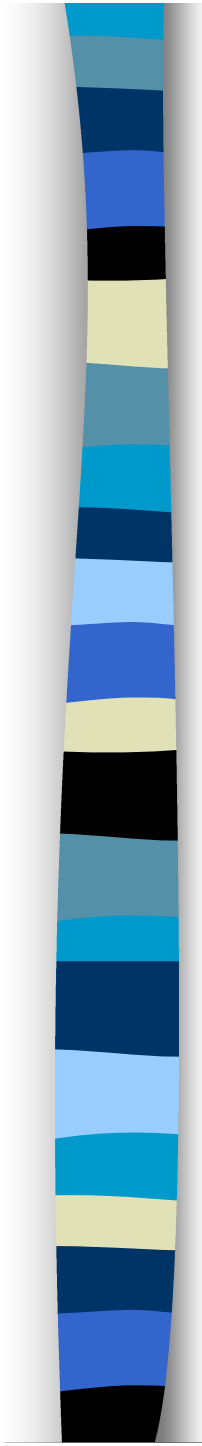
- Develop 5 new clinical information sheets

Train-the-Trainer workshop

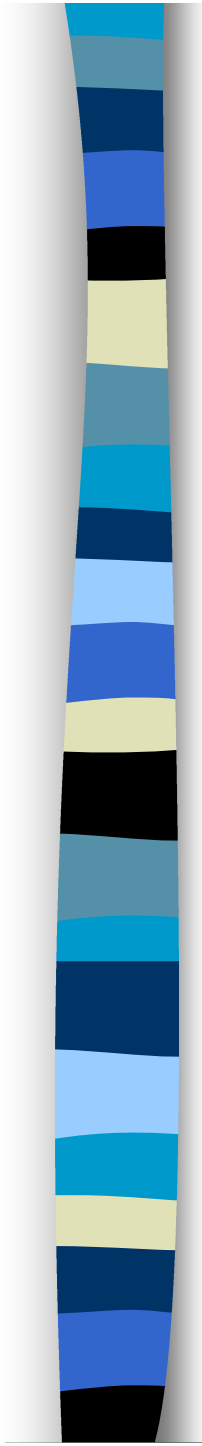
Purpose:

To train Aged Care GP Panel staff so that they can implement an education module, based on the Kit, with their local GPs and aged care home staff.



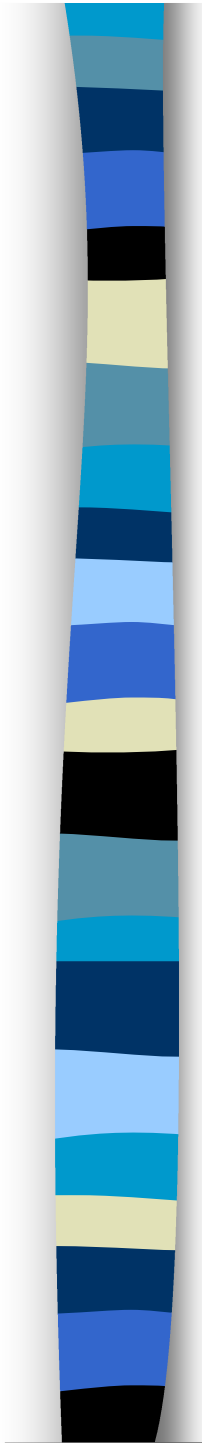
Active Learning Module: Tools of the Trade

- Predisposing & reflective activities



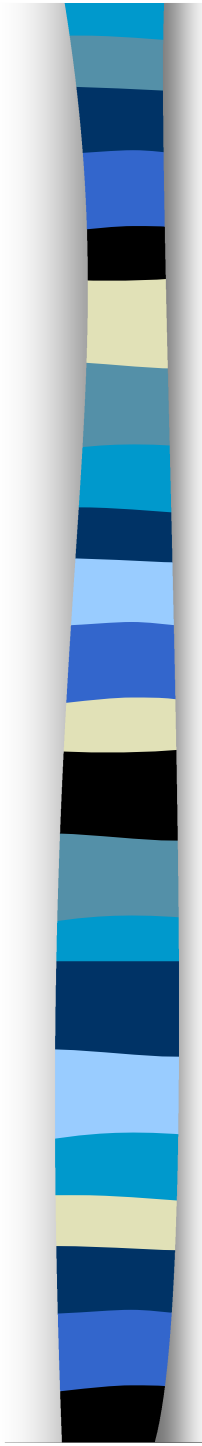
Positive feedback
