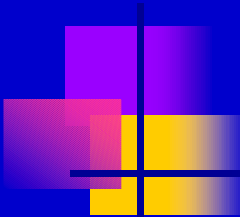


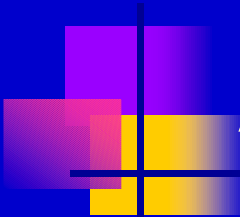

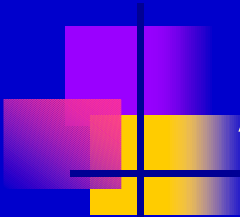
Overview of Plan

 - Consumer information services via website



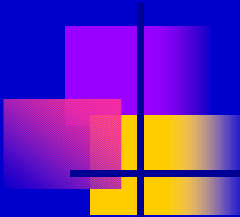

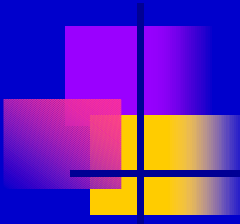
Activities Required

- *Identification of education, information and training needs of GPs*
 - Strategies for use of practice nurses
- *Provision of appropriate education, training and support*
 - Who to
 - GPs
 - Nurses
 - Practice Staff
 - Other health care providers
 - About
 - Sign on payments for asthma, cervical screening and for diabetes recall/reminder system
 - SIP activities (asthma, diabetes, cervical screening, mental health)
 - Outcomes payments (diabetes, cervical screening)
 - Claiming for above items
 - Any changes to the program over the life of the agreement



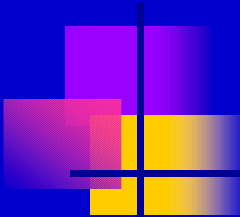
Education Training and Support

- *Integrating the new budget initiatives with existing initiatives (EPC, MAHS)*
- *Highlighting potential for practice nurses*
- *Information of managing co-morbidities*
- *Training on spirometry, asthma action plans, self medication education, review of medications and assessment of asthma severity*



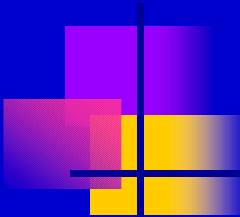
Education Training and Support

 - *Promote IT infrastructure requirements*



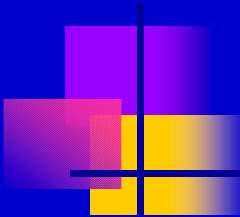
Capacity Building and Linkages

Capacity Building and Linkages

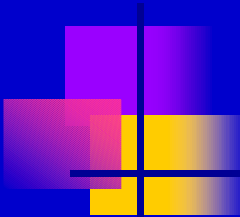
- *Raise awareness within GP, communities and other services*
 - Systemic approaches to chronic disease management
 - Of asthma 3+ plan, diabetes, mental health, promoting cervical screening
 - Collaboration with community awareness raising initiatives
 - Of relevant IM/IT work (eg GPCG group)
- *Facilitate linkages to specialist, nursing and allied health professionals and non government agencies*
 - Regular communication
 - Development of referral and feedback policies
 - Identify opportunities for outreach and telemedicine services



Capacity Building and Linkages

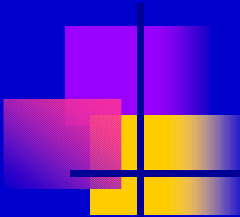
■ *Promote utilisation of practice nurses*

- Clinical nursing services
- Foster links with other providers
- Assist with chronic disease management
- Facilitate implementation of chronic disease budget initiatives
- Coordinate patient services
- Assist with management of clinical environment
- Undertake health promotion and preventative health activities
- Assist in self management education and medication reviews
- Manage human and material resources



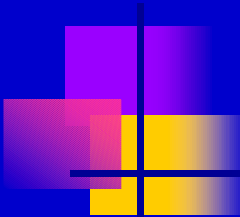
Capacity Building and Linkages

 - *Raise awareness within GP, communities and other services of HIC business improvement activities*



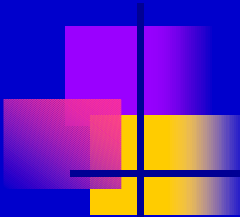
Professional Development and Quality Assurance

- Provide or facilitate access to professional development and quality assurance and clinical audit activities in chronic disease prevention
- Provide or facilitate familiarisation training for the Better Outcomes in Mental Health Care initiative
- Provide assistance with performance feedback (eg diabetes recall register system)
- Assist practices in providing data that supports evaluation of initiatives
- Promote uptake of relevant clinical guidelines



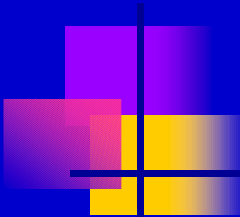
IM and Systems Support

 - *Provide feedback on the uptake and key issues associated with the plan*



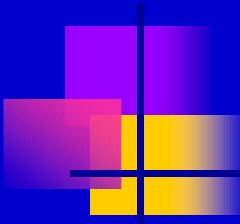

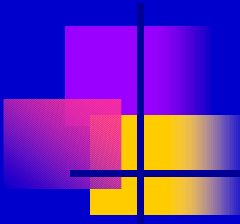
