GPDV questions for consultation

- Could divisions classify most of their strategies within a common suite of strategic approaches
- e.g.
 - GP professional development
 - GP staff professional development
 - Joint CPD including other stakeholders
 - Practice systems development and support
 - GP health system integration – primary care
 - GP health system integration – hospital care
 - Public education / health promotion
