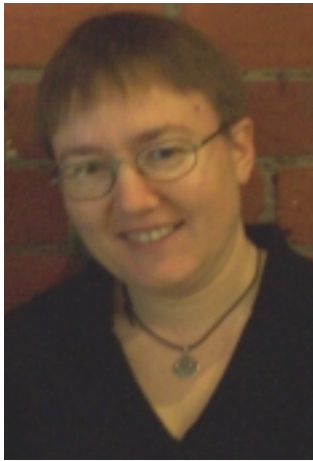


Introducing the Workshop Facilitators
