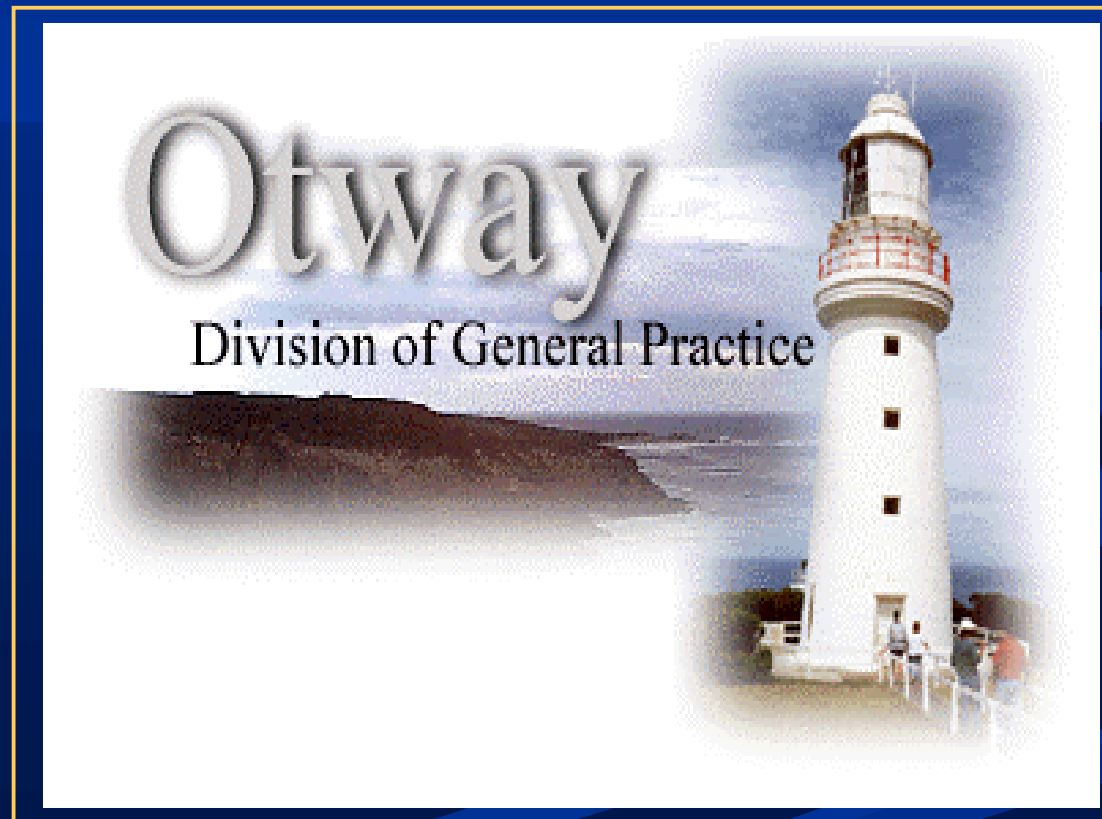

- **Provide ODGP nurses with clinical and professional support to enhance their professional identity and role within the general practice setting.**

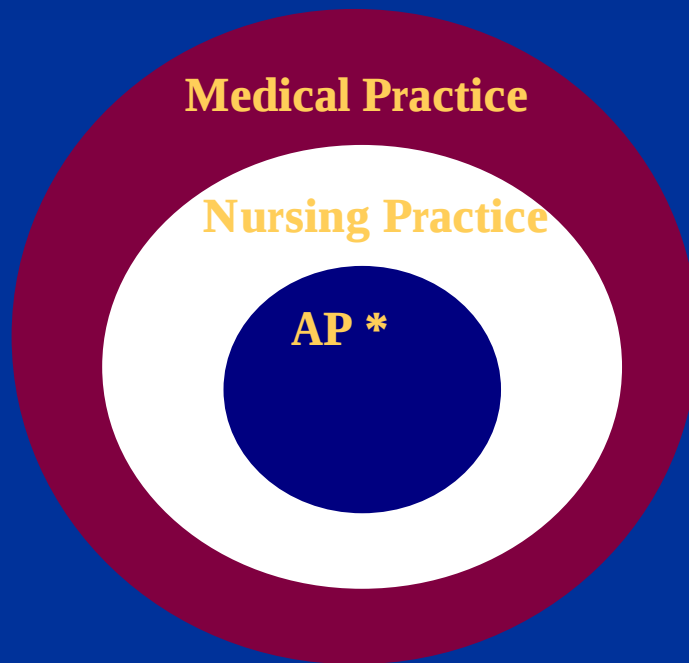

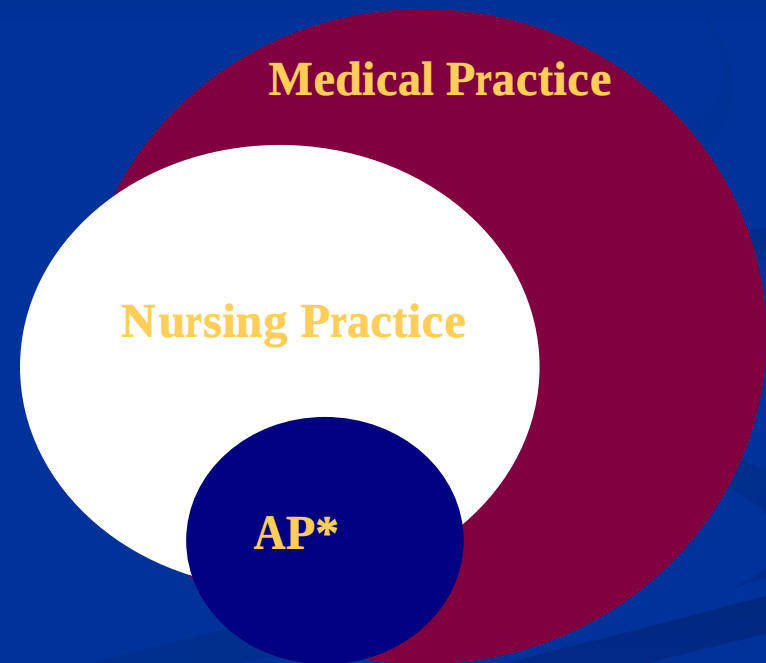
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Current Nurse Models of Employment

Preamble

Currently nurses working in General Practice may be either Registered Nurses (Registered Nurse Division 1 in the State of Victoria – henceforth abbreviated to RN Div 1) or Enrolled Nurses (Registered Nurse Division 2 in the State of Victoria – henceforth abbreviated to RN Div 2) (See Fact Sheet No 2). Where Enrolled Nurses are employed in General Practice they must be supervised (either directly or indirectly) by a Registered Nurse (RN Div 1) (See Fact Sheet No 6).
