How the GPV subsidy works - Information for Practice Nurses

2. Open the [practice nurse training calendar](#). Follow the link information about the course you are interested.

Items listed in the training calendar marked in **red** attract a 50% fee subsidy from GPV.

3. Download the course registration form from the training calendar link.
4. Contact your [local division NiGP program officer](#) and request to have a subsidy application form emailed to you.
5. Complete the course registration and subsidy application forms, attach a payment of 50% of the course fee and mail to
